

RESOLUTION NO. 1318

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, WASHINGTON, certifying funding for the City of Des Moines Redondo Boardwalk Repair project.

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines adopted the 2016-2021 Capital Improvement Program budget including full funding for the Redondo Boardwalk Repair project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines was selected for a grant from the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (hereinafter TIB) and on November 20, 2015 the TIB announced that \$360,000.00 in state TIB funds would be available for the project subject to certification full funding for the improvements is available pursuant to RCW 47.26.084, and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines adopted the 2016-2035 Transportation Improvement Plan and recommends boardwalk repairs to restore public access to the facility that has been permanently closed due to a major storm event in November 2014 in which a State of Emergency was declared, and

WHEREAS, design of this Project is complete and once all permits are secured the City shall advertise the project for construction bids; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Funding for the Redondo Boardwalk Repair Project is secured and the City Council certifies that the necessary local matching funds will be available for construction.
