

RESOLUTION NO. 1232

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, WASHINGTON, fixing a time for a public hearing to consider Draft Ordinance No. 13-011 which amends the City of Des Moines Sign Code codified as Chapter 18.42 DMMC to clarify that public readerboard signs are allowed as off premise signs and to help promote economic development, and to address community concerns.

WHEREAS, the City Council is considering a variety of means by which wayfinding and communication to the public for civic events purposes important public notices can be achieved, and

WHEREAS, the City is embarking on significant street improvements in the Gateway of South 216th Street and seeking a means to enhance communications to the public near city facilities in this area as well as throughout the Marina District and in other areas having high public visibility, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is considering some refinements in the Sign Code to help promote economic development, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing is required for adoption of an ordinance which amends a portion of the Title 18 DMMC commonly referred to as the Sign Code; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The matter of amending Chapter 18.42 DMMC to clarify regulations that provide for public readerboards signs as off premise signs is set for a public hearing before the City Council on Thursday, July 25, 2013, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon
