

RESOLUTION NO. 1285

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, WASHINGTON, certifying funding for the City of Des Moines S. 216th Street, Segment 1-A Improvements (24th Ave. S. to SR99).

WHEREAS, the City Council of Des Moines exists to promote the welfare of the citizens of Des Moines, Washington, and recognizes that improvements to S. 216th Street, Segment 1-A are necessary to sustain mobility and serve economic growth of the City, and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Transportation Plan for the City of Des Moines, was adopted as an element of the Comprehensive Plan and recommends that this roadway be widened to five lanes including bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and

WHEREAS, design of this project is complete, the City is securing the necessary right of way for construction of the project, and once right of way is secured will prepare to advertize the project for construction bids, and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines was selected for a grant from the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (hereinafter TIB) and on November 24, 2014 the TIB announced that \$2,800,000 in state TIB funds would be available for the project subject to certification full funding for the improvements is available pursuant to RCW 47.26.084, and


WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines adopted the 2015-2020 Capital Improvement Program budget including full funding for the S. 216th Street Segment 1-A Improvements (24th Ave. S to SR99); now, therefore,
